The Collin County A&M University Mother's Club (Collin County Aggie Moms) is sponsoring a Live and Silent Auction on Saturday, March 27, 2010. CCAM is a group of mothers whose son(s) or daughter(s) currently attend or formerly attended Texas A&M University. CCAM was originally chartered in 1981 as Plano A&M University Mothers' Club, to provide support and promote activities to support Texas A&M and its students. CCAM is only one of some 126 Aggie Moms clubs formed to support TAMU. Collectively Aggie Moms have donated as much as \$600,000+ per year in donations to student organizations and scholarships. CCAM consistently ranks among the top five (5) clubs in donations and scholarships. CCAM membership last year totaled almost 300 and awarded 11 scholarships amounting to \$1,000 each and over \$13,000 in support of organizations.

In order to raise money to support our students, CCAM sponsors various fundraising events throughout the year. For the Spring Fundraiser for the 2009-10 year, we will be conducting an Auction in conjunction with our 4th Annual Chili Cook-off, of which 100% of the proceeds will go toward this support of TAMU. Suggested items include gift certificates, merchandise, services, events, athletic tickets, baked goods, memberships, etc.
